### Location and Transportation

The Studio School is located at 117 West 95<sup>th</sup> Street between Columbus and Amsterdam Avenues on the Upper West Side of Manhattan. The closest subway stops are the 1, 2, and 3 lines at 96<sup>th</sup> Street and Broadway, and the B and C lines at 96<sup>th</sup> Street and Central Park West. The nearest bus lines are the M104 on Broadway, the M7 and M11 lines that operate on Columbus and Amsterdam Avenues, and the crosstown M96 bus that stops at 96<sup>th</sup> Street and Columbus Avenue. Kindergarten, Elementary School, and Middle School students who meet the minimum age and distance requirements set by the NYC Department of Education's Office of Pupil Transportation are eligible for Student MetroCards.
